




Finding the full-text of an article by using

If the database in which you are searching does not have the full text of an article you would like, look for the  button to help you locate the article.

Click on the  button and our Article Linker technology automatically searches for the article in other STL locations (i.e., other STL electronic databases, the library's catalog of print subscriptions, and STL's interlibrary loan resources).

Scenario 1: Article is available electronically in another database

If the search finds that the article is available in another STL database, it will show:



If the search finds that the full text is not available in an electronic database but might be found if you search the library's catalog for a print version, it will show:
